Restorer's Tip Sub pan removal:

Removing sub pan assemblies (dipper trays) is not an easy task and usually results in bruises or cuts to your hands. To easily remove any dipper tray, place the oil pan on a rug or padded surface on the floor. Place the end of a wooden baseball bat in the oil pump opening and position it to use it as a pry bar to remove the part. (See following pictures)





Place one foot on the edge of the pan opposite of the oil pump opening and give it a quick push. The pan will rotate and the dipper tray will pop out. No cuts or bruises...but maybe a little oil on your shoe or pant leg. Works every time!
